What is **Child Evangelism Fellowship®**?

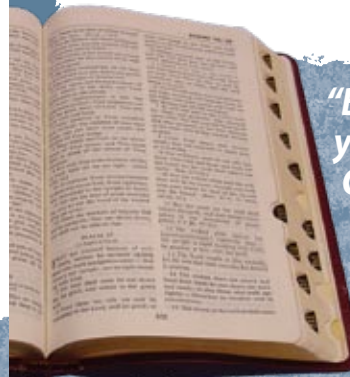

Conditions of acceptance

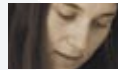
- ◆ Born again and seeking to live a consecrated Christian life.

Where is the training?

The training is at Kilchzimmer, the European CEF headquarters, which is 40 kms south of Basel in the Swiss Jura mountains. The quiet and beautiful surroundings are conducive to study. The centre has comfortable rooms and offers an international cuisine.

What is the goal?

To prepare you for the work of evangelising and discipling children at home or overseas and to enable you to train and encourage others in this work.



What is included?

You will enjoy a cross-cultural experience as you study together with others from Europe and various regions of the world. There are separate classrooms for English and German sections. The subjects taught include:

- ◆ Biblical basis of child evangelism
- ◆ Helping the local church reach the children
- ◆ Teaching the Gospel to children
- ◆ Leading a child to Christ
- ◆ Helping a saved child to grow
- ◆ Conducting different kinds of children's ministries: Good News Clubs®, camps, open-air work, Holiday Bible Clubs®
- ◆ Teaching a Bible lesson
- ◆ Child Study
- ◆ Special needs of children from Moslem or Roman Catholic backgrounds
- ◆ Establishing and administrating a full-time ministry amongst children
- ◆ Training and helping others to reach children
- ◆ Victorious life
- ◆ How to teach doctrine to children
- ◆ Working with junior teens
- ◆ Problems children face in the contemporary world

There are six classes of 40 minutes each day, Monday to Friday. Time is given for personal study and assignments. Teachers are available for counsel and advice.
